

Directions to NHTV Studio, 127 Washington Ave., No. Haven: Phone (203) 234-0025

1. Directions from Hartford Traveling South on I-91: Take Exit #12. At the ramp take a left onto Washington Ave. Follow Washington for about 1/8 mile until you see McDonald's on your right. Slow down; immediately after McDonald's take the driveway on your right; it is a little hidden. When you enter you will see a large white Citizen's Bank building on the left. Pass that. **Go down the driveway to the back** (the parking lot is in the back opposite to the building). Park on the right; lock your car.

2. Walk towards where the two large buildings form a connecting bridge. Walk under that; take the descending stairs to your left; go through the glass doors and walk up the hallway. NHTV is in the middle of the long narrow hallway on your right. **The phone number at OneWorld is (203) 407-0250. After 7PM call Ms. Shāni at (203) 393-5253.**

3. Directions from 95 going west towards New York: After crossing over the Quinnipiac Bridge, take exit 48 to get onto 91 North towards Hartford. Proceed onto 91 North to exit 11. Take exit 11; at the ramp take a right; go to the intersection (to the traffic light). **This is Washington Ave & Route 22. Take a left onto Washington Ave.** Go up about 1/8 mile until you see the McDonald's on the left. **Do not pass the McDonalds.** Immediately before reaching Mc, there are two driveways into Citizen's Bank; take the second driveway. This is closest to the McDonald's. **Follow directions at # 2 above.**

4. Directions from downtown New Haven Via 1- 91: Take exit 11; at the ramp take a right; go to the intersection (to the traffic light). This is Washington and Route 22. **Follow directions at # 3 above.**

5. From the Merritt Parkway Going North: Take exit 63; at the ramp take a right; go to the second set of lights at the intersection of Washington and Route 22. Stay in the left lane. **This is Washington and Route 22.** See #3 above.

If you run into any difficulty, please call the station at (203) 234-0025 for directions, or call (203) 393-5253, Ms. Shāni. If you are not familiar with the area, please allow yourself extra travel time.

Critically Important Guidelines for Participation in OneWorld, Inc. TV Education Programs:

- A. **We request that you Do Not Wear a White or a Bright Red top & that guests follow all guidelines – No Exceptions**
- B. **Please do not arrive at NHTV before 7:30PM, unless by special pre-arrangements with N'Zinga Shāni, program producer. We try to start taping by 8:15PM with the goal of finishing by 9:15PM; occasionally we finish at 9:25PM.**
- C. The program is divided into Parts 1 & 2. We present information as a semi-documentary, so it can be easily absorbed.
- D. **It is important that guests send us program information at least 10 days before the date of the program.**
- E. We ask that graphic info to be shown on the screen be entered in a laptop computer & brought to the studio for use
- F. We provide educational programs to the community; we do not promote commercial entities
- G. It is imperative that guests are well prepared to answer all questions & provide information in a clear & crisp manner
- H. **We ask that guests use clear & specific language. no ACRONYMS or subject jargon; our goal is to inform the community**
- I. **If for any reason you cannot keep your appointment to appear on a scheduled TV program, please call Ms. Shāni at (203) 407-0250 ASAP and inform her.** A great deal of technical preparation goes into each program; other people travel long distances to crew the show and to be guests. **Each guest is important to the success of the program.** Your lack of appearance will affect the final product. **Please be thoughtful and inform us if you decide NOT to participate.**
